



RULES FOR USE OF DOCKSIDE MOORING

- 1) Members should fly the Docksider Burgee when occupying Club Moorings.
- 2) Docksider moorings are available on a first come first served basis.
- 3) As a general rule, club moorings are intended for single vessels up to 14 metres in length. However, common sense and weather may allow for a temporary raft up of up of three smaller vessels. Overnight raft ups are not recommended due to unforeseen weather.
- 4) Docksider Moorings are available for use by members for a 24 hour period.
- 5) Docksider members are not permitted to leave their boats unattended on Docksider moorings for long periods.
- 6) The Docksider moorings are serviced annually, but notwithstanding Docksider Buyers Group accepts no liability for any damage sustained by vessels using these moorings, be it Docksider members or others. Members who find a Docksider mooring unserviceable should report any problems immediately to Julie Preston on 0405 537 494.
- 7) Vessels occupying Docksider moorings should have current registration and comprehensive insurance.
